

Speech and Language Therapy drop-in sessions for pre-school children*

If you're worried about your child's talking or understanding please come to a 'drop-in' session.

A Speech and Language Therapist will be there to:

- Listen to you and discuss your concerns
- Watch your child playing
- Assess the needs of your child

Please bring with you:

- Your red book – provided by your Health Visitor
- Any written information from pre-school

Please note if a person other than the child's legal guardian is bringing your child to the drop-in we need written permission to see your child.

At the end of the session, the Speech and Language Therapist:

- Will talk with you about ideas to help your child
- May offer a further appointment
- May suggest that you contact them after a certain period of time to let them know how your child is doing
